



American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Update



As of April 1, 2024

The Nevada Department of Health and Human Services received American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding for **148 projects** and initiatives.

As of April 1, 2024, **48 projects are 100% complete**, 18 projects are more than 50% complete and about **34.5%** of total funding has been expended.

With deobligations of some project funding, more than **\$549 million** is budgeted to Department projects.

79% of DHHS projects are **statewide**, 16% are specific to Clark County, 3% Washoe County and 2% specific to the rural areas.



Public Health

More than **\$75 million** in ARPA funding was allocated to public health programs which have been transformational in supporting local, state, and academic public health programs in Nevada. Funding has supported foundational public health needs in the areas of infectious disease, family planning, maternal and child health, environmental health, laboratory services, chronic disease, and others. Projects have ranged in scope from physical infrastructure to human capital and filling immediate and future workforce needs.
